Bill Biche, at 83 years of age (1929-2013), died suddenly at his home in Philadelphia in his favorite chair on Saturday, Feb. 23, at approximately 5:30 p.m. Buick enthusiasts lost one of their greatest. Bill and his wife Annette were married on May 9, 1953. They have 8 children and 19 grandchildren.

After their marriage, Annette wanted an MG, and that was Bill and Annette's first collector car. Bill was a member of the MG Club and the LCOC (Lincoln Continental Owners Club). He was also a member of the Buick Club of America (BCA # 568), and in 1976 he became a charter member of the BCA Finger Lakes Chapter.

Bill enjoyed restoring and maintaining his vehicles. He had retired from the Eastman Kodak Company after working there many years as a Mechanical Engineer and living in the Rochester, NY area. He was well known for his design, management, and organizational skills and served as President of the Buick Club of America from 1992-1994, making his Finger Lakes Chapter proud. Bill proudly served on the Board of Directors of the Buick Heritage Alliance when it was first organized, and was instrumental in the early cataloging efforts of the BHA Literature collection.
