(BCA) is an international, not-for-profit organization dedicated to encouraging the maintenance, restoration, preservation and enjoyment of all models of Buicks produced by the **Buick Motor Division of General Motors.** With more than 8,000 members who own 20,000 plus automobiles built by Buick, the Buick Club promotes activities, resources and friendships. Members can enjoy nationwide events, publications and expert technical resources. Chapters of the BCA are available to promote local networking, but you must belong to the National BCA organization to be eligible to join a local Chapter of the BCA. Ownership of a Buick automobile is not required to be a member of the BCA; The Buick Club of America is not affiliated with Buick Motor Division, nor with General Motors.
